BEACHPORT GOLF CLUB - COMMITTEE ROLES

Board member roles

Co-ordinate and complete all key tasks that enable the club to function as per the Objects of the Beachport Golf Club. Make recommendations to the Board. Communicate with other Sub-committees where required. Manage risk.

Sub-committee roles

MARKETING Communicate with the BGC membership at least 4 times per year by email (Club Secretary is to disseminate these communications). Use social media, recognise sponsors and competition winners on a weekly basis. Monitor both State, Federal Government & WRC grant programs and recommend applications where appropriate to the board. Assist with compilation of any grants or sponsorship requests. Co-ordinate fund raising activities. Increase BGC revenue and profile with innovative and new ideas and activities.

COMPETITIONS Compile and disseminate the yearly golf program by 1st April each calendar year. Advertise and run all yearly competitions that involve the BGC (including weekly men's and women's competitions, New Years and Open day tournaments, twilight golf and SPGW). Foster player development, membership, and junior golf programs. Appoint a match committee if required.

HOSPITALITY & EVENTS Organise, communicate, and facilitate all catering and bar service for all events held at the BGC. Purchase necessary supplies and products to cater for all functions. Communicate with the clubhouse cleaner and supply cleaning products. Kitchen and bar activities and cleanliness to comply with health and safety regulations. Maintain or exceed current levels of presentation of the clubhouse, entrance, and gardens. Enlist assistance from membership when required.

FACILITIES & GROUNDS Manage all aspects of the golf course including fairways, greens, tee blocks, surrounds, bunkers, and vegetation. Prepare the course for all competitions. Manage and communicate with the green keeper. Inspect all equipment, servicing, and maintenance records, ensuring they are up to date and complete. Monitor cleanliness and organisation of equipment shed. Provide guidance and instruction of tasks required by the green keeper. Comply with chemical storage regulations. Ensure the clubhouse and sheds are in good condition and are structurally sound and safe. Report any issues with equipment or buildings to the Board. Enlist assistance from membership when required. Research, report and implement ways to decrease costs.

OTHER PROGRAMS

JUNIOR GOLF CLINICS: Catering for youngsters under the age of 14, programs are held over summer, introducing and teaching the basic fundamentals of golf. Sessions have been sponsored by Bendigo Bank (Robe & Districts Community Bank) and Golf Australia.

GIN 'N GOLF: Introducing new members to golf with clinics and social golf, these sessions have been sponsored by Argyle Travel & Cruise.

NIGHT GOLF: The club have recently purchased glow in the dark balls and tees, along with fairway markers and lighting, thanks to grant funding from Wattle Range Council & Office for Recreation Sport and Racing.

GOLFING GAMES EXPLAINED..



AMBROSE: Ambrose is played with either two, three or four team players. Each player tees off, after which the captain selects the best drive and marks the ball's position using a tee. All players then pick up their balls and hit their next shots from there, placing their ball within a club length of the marker if it is on the fairway, or dropping within a club-length if it's in the rough. The captain then chooses the best shot again and this process continues until the ball is holed. The best ball score is recorded and the lowest total net score wins.

COLOURED BALL: In teams of three or four, each player plays their own ball, and one plays the coloured ball. The coloured ball score is counted for each hole on the team's scorecard. The team with the lowest coloured ball wins.

FOURBALL BETTERBALL (4BBB) Teams of two play their own ball and count the 'better ball' score on each hole.

MATCHPLAY: Matchplay is a hole-by-hole game where the lowest score wins the hole. Wins are recorded as +, losses recorded as - and same score as O. The match is over when one player leads by more than the number of holes left to play.

MULTIPLICATION STABLEFORD: This is a 4 ball stableford event. Both players record their individual score and their stableford points on the card. The teams overall result is determined by multiplying these 2 stableford points. The teams overall result is also to be recorded on the card. If Player A has 4 (strokes)for 2 (points)and Player B has 3 for 3, the team has $2 \times 3 = 6$ stableford points for that hole. If one player has 0 points for a hole, then the team records 0 points.

PAR: Par scoring is basically like matchplay but an individual game. The player that finishes with the most shots up (+) or if it's a brutal day, the least shots down (-) is the winner.

PINEHURST: Played with a partner and both players tee off on all holes. Both players then switch golf balls. Player A plays Player B's drive & vice versa. After each player has hit the second shot, they select the best ball of the second shots and from that ball they only play one ball in an alternate shot format. The handicap of each team is calculated by adding both members' individual handicaps and multiplying it by $3/8$.

STABLEFORD: The aim is to score the most points:

3 strokes under (albatross) = 5 points

2 strokes under (eagle) = 4 points

1 stroke under (birdie) = 3 points

Even par = 2 points

1 stroke over (bogey) = 1 point

2 strokes over (double bogey or worse) = 0 points

STROKE: In stroke play, the score is derived by counting the total number of strokes taken until the player picks their ball out of the hole. Strokes are tallied for a gross score, then the handicap is subtracted for a net score.
